- Why does the patient have to take the test somewhere else to use it? The library does not have a safe area away from other patrons and staff or webcams for patron use.
- Can children take this test?
 According to the U.S. FDA's Dec. 16 2020 News Release, this test can be taken by individuals four years and older as long as an adult is collecting the sample for the test.
 15 years and older are authorized to collect their own.
- Where did the library get these tests from? These tests were purchased by the State of Ohio and given to libraries and other places to distribute to the public.
- Is there a way to do the test without internet or without an eMed? The Emergency Use Authorization from the FDA specifically states, "The BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test is to be performed only with the supervision of a telehealth proctor."

If the patient wants a valid result that they can show an employer, school, or other organization, they must follow all instructions.
